



## REQUIREMENTS TO COACH IN REGION 13

There are four (4) requirements to be a Head Coach or an Assistant Coach in Region 13:

1. ALL Coaches and Assistant Coaches must complete and submit an AYSO National "Volunteer Application".
2. ALL Coaches and Assistant Coaches must complete and submit a Region 13 "Coach Application". This form can be found on the Region 13 Website under the "Coaches" Tab and then the "Coach Application" link.
3. ALL Coaches and Assistant Coaches must attend the Coach Safe Haven Certification course, unless Region 13 has a written record that the coach (or asst. coach) has previously received Safe Haven Certification. The "safe haven" portion of the Referee training courses is NOT sufficient to fulfill this requirement.
4. ALL Coaches and Assistant Coaches who have not previously done so must attend and satisfactorily complete the required Coach Training Course for the Division in which they wish to coach. These Mandatory Courses are as follows:
  - For the U6 Division: the U6 Coaching Course
  - For the U7 & U8 Divisions: the U8 Coaching Course
  - For the U10 Division: the U10 Coaching Course.
  - For the U12 Division: the U12 Coaching Course
  - For the U14 Division: the U12 Coaching Course – BUT the Intermediate Course is highly recommended and an Intermediate Coach Certification is required to coach in U14 in any Area 1C Program (All-Stars, Tournaments &/or YDP)
  - For the U16 Division: the Advanced Coaching Course
  - For the U19 Division: the Advanced Coaching Course

\*\*\* Please Note – any coach who wishes to be a Head Coach or an Asst. Coach in an Advanced Play Program (Graduation Series, All-Stars and/or YDP) must have a Coach Certification one level higher than the minimum certification listed above for U8 through U14.
