Board of Directors' Minutes

November 12, 2015

October Minutes: The minutes were previously approved via email.

REPORTS

Uniforms – MST and All Stars - Ivonne Penichet reported that uniforms for MST have been ordered and should arrive next week by Wednesday or Thursday. The number of BU12 teams has changed. There are now 5 not 6. Uniforms for All Stars will be ordered in December once the number of teams is set. Heidi will should have that number by the first week of December. It was generally agreed Region 13 will use colors Red (or Burgundy) and Black for All Star uniforms.

There was general discussion about All Stars player sweatshirts. Pam reported that the vendor charges \$25 per piece for an order of 300 or more. It was suggested we need to order 300 for a price of about \$7500. This order would not include sweatshirts for coaches, assistant coaches, parents, etc. It was agreed that Region 13 will cover the cost of the sweatshirts for players only.

It was agreed that coaches should get player sizes from their teams by December 19th, and Heidi will get that information to Pam on the 20th so she can order the sweatshirts. Pam will arrange delivery to the clubhouse by January 9th.

Coach's Report – Heidi Taylor was present and reviewed her email report:

All Star player registration will continue until November 30th. Players are not required to attend a tryout to be eligible to play in tryouts. However, most players did attend at least one tryouts.

Trophies - Kelly Leyva organized the trophy order. U5 have been distributed. U6, U7, and U8 will become available for pick up starting Friday, November 13th to all coaches who have complete and turned their team's rating to DCAs. U10 through U14 trophies and participation pins are scheduled to be complete in

the next week or so. We used Mark Evan's design (the same one on the uniform sleeve) on for both trophies and pins.

Grad Series - Marco Quezada has agreed to oversee the Grad Series with Josh Kreinberg as GU8 Coordinator and Robert Fletcher as BU8 Coordinator. Josh and Robert are actively recruiting coaches. The registration form is on the R13 website. AL will send an eblast to families.

U5 program - U5 concluded on November 1st with Anne Tipton and family passing out trophies and goodie bags. A new U5 coordinator is needed for next season.

UD Playoffs - 4 UD teams made it to playoffs, which will be played on Sunday, November 15th.

Referee's Report – Bill Owen reported on Kareem's behalf that there has lately been several red card penalties. There was general discussion about refraining from heavy-handed penalties on the coaches. There was also discussion about Refs for playoffs. Kareem later reported that there is a Ref class offered in South Pasadena on December 12th.

Financial Report – Angel Mazariegos had no new reports.

Team Managers – Kelly Leyva reported that 100 trophies have arrived for U6 and U8. She will distribute them on Friday night 11/13 at the clubhouse. Her U10 order is processing and will likely arrive next week. She ordered participation medals for U10 and pins for U12 and U14. Kelly will email Team Managers an invitation to the Year-End Dinner.

Sponsorships – Chris McDonald reported that \$11,900 had been collected in sponsorship donations. About 70% of these donations were made online. He will send a friendly email reminder to encourage more participation.

MST – Pam Vigil reported that there are 106 MST teams. However there is not enough interest in MST to include U16 and U19 this year. She recommended closing U16 and U19. She further reported that Region 13 needs to supply 2 to 4 volunteers for the tournament and Refs are needed.

Fields – Marco Quezada and John Sweet. Marco reported that on November 23rd a portion of Muir North will not be available for 3 months due to improvements the school is making. This will affect play through. He will find out how much of the field will remain usable.

Marco and Bill will arrange fields for MST by Nov 21st. Marco will have Area H graded and cleaned before MST, and will have tents repaired. There was discussion about securing fields for MST team practices and scrimmages, without interfering with fall season team practices. It was suggested that MST practices could start on Sunday, Nov 15th. Marco and John will make arrangements.

There was discussion about safety issues at various fields – broken glass, generators out of gas or failed batteries, and sprinklers on during practice. John reported that we need to find a new field painter for next fall as our current painter is retiring. He also reported that Blair is missing goal parts and could use a custom-made box next fall to keep everything together.

There was discussion about conflicting user groups at various fields due to field closures, and the lack of access to Area H. There was brief discussion about how and when field permits are obtained and why documentation of all field permits can sometimes be problematic.
